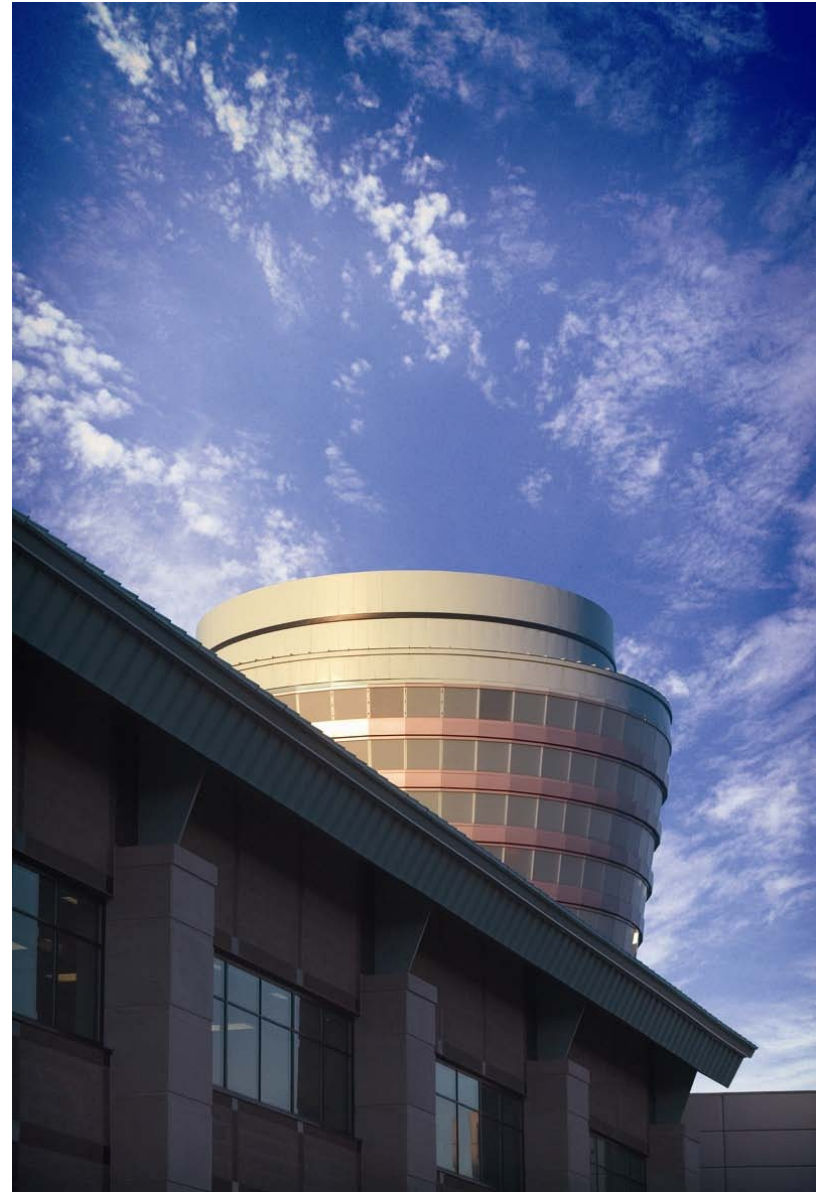

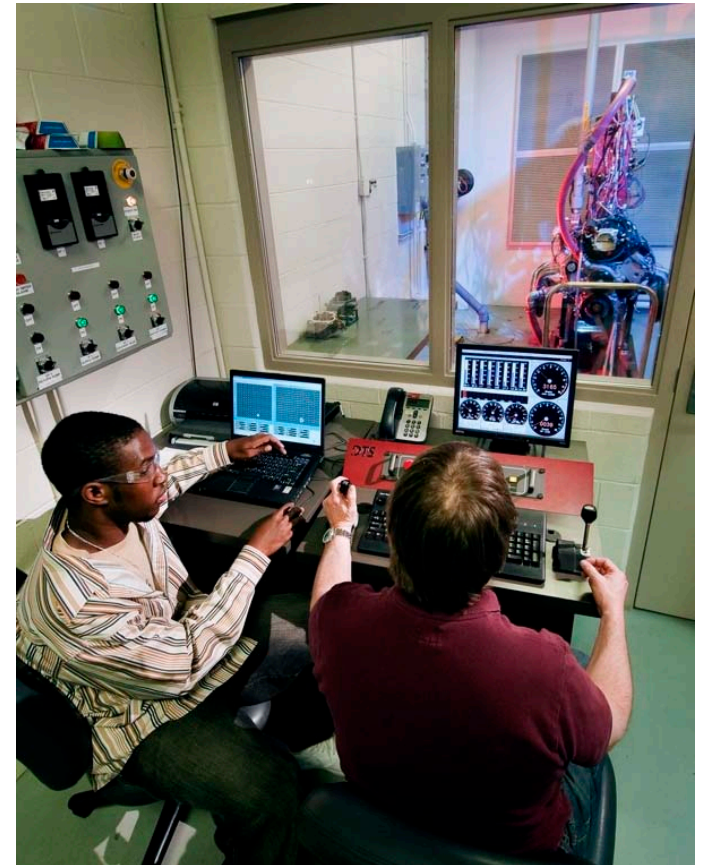

The Power of Partnerships

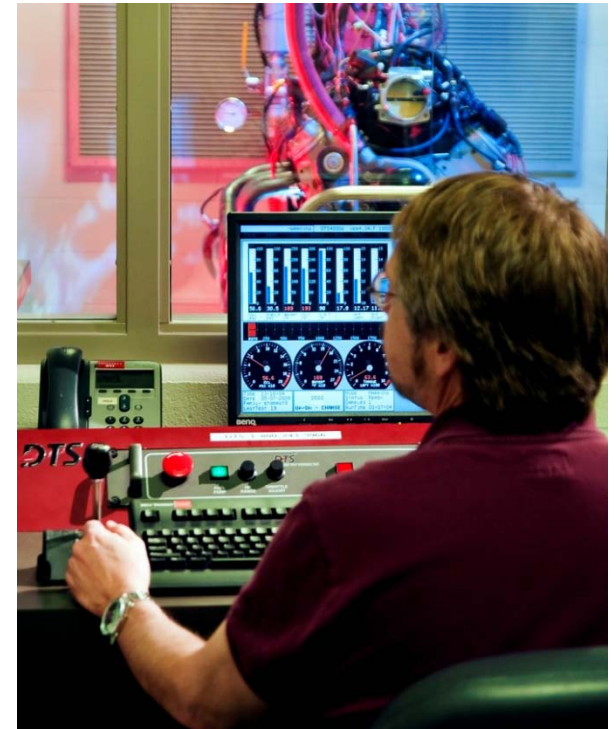
- Supports dual and concurrent enrollment
